January saw a slightly higher number of intakes.

APS received 150 reports of abuse, neglect and exploitation in January 2013. The average of reports for July 2012 through December 2012 was 132.

In January, 51% of the total intakes entered were closed contacts (73) (i.e., reports in which either the alleged victim did not meet the statutory definition of vulnerable adult, or the alleged conduct did not meet the statutory definition of abuse, neglect or exploitation, or both).

From July 2012 through December 2012, the average for closed contacts was 55%.

Investigators completed 90 investigations and returned findings of substantiation in 10% of those cases. As reported earlier in the Adult Protective Services Annual Report, the overall substantiation for calendar year 2012 was 14%.

From December 2012 to the end of January 2013, the weekly average for open cases increased from 170 to 173, and the weekly average case load per investigator increased from 12 to 13.




A concern raised last month by the House Human Services Committee that fewer cases were being investigated is not borne out by the data.









Demographic Data for Substantiated Cases January 2013











Demographic Data for Substantiated Cases January 2013






Demographic Data for Unsubstantiated Cases for January 2013
